codes, inactive codes, and point codes. A parcel code is used in the map for a parcel with a single map code with the addition of a trailing comma and lowercase letter to make the subparcel code unique. A parcel lower left corner of the text or the end of the text leader line. In the example to the left, the tiny parcel has subparcels "12354300,a", "12354300,b", and "12354300,c". An inactive code is used to indicate the parcel code example, subparcel "12354300,b" will become parcel "12354302" and "12354300,c" will become "12354301". A portion of the property is marked with a square symbol, and the code for the point is at the end of a leader line. A example, "32112345" is a point code.
